THE HOLY GOD

PRAYER OF INVOCATION

CALL TO WORSHIP *(Justin)* [stand]

Reader: Psalm 34:3 Oh, magnify the Lord with me!
Church: *Let us exalt His name together.*

PSALM, HYMN, or SPIRITUAL SONG: *Praise To The Lord, The Almighty*
PSALM, HYMN, or SPIRITUAL SONG: *Psalm 8*

READING OF GOD'S WORD *(James)* [stand]

Prov. 15:1–18 Devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture. (1 Tim. 4:13)

OUR GUILT

CONFESSION OF SIN *(Chris S.)* [sit]

Reader: God's moral law commands all people: "you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength" (Deut. 6:5) & "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Mk 12:31).
Church: *Under the misery of sin, we are unable to keep even God's fourth moral commandment. Left to ourselves, we forget the Lord's Day, and hold nothing as sacred.*

JESUS CHRIST

Reader: Q. 25. Who is the Redeemer of God's elect? *(Chris S.)*
Church: *A. The only Redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ, who, being the eternal Son of God, became man, and so was and continues to be God and man, in two distinct natures and one person, forever.*
(Gal. 3:13; 1 Tim. 2:5; John 1:14; 1 Tim. 3:16; Rom. 9:5; Col. 2:9)

Reader: Yes, in order to save His people by His grace, God the Son took on flesh and fully kept His law for each person whom He redeemed.

Church: *Christ fulfilled all righteousness and paid for all sin on behalf of all who love Him.*

PRAYER OF REPENTANCE

ASSURANCE OF PARDON *(Uriel)* [stand]

Reader: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and (Titus 3:5)
Church: *the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.*

GRATITUDE

Reader: *(Uriel)* Followers of Christ joyfully receive the moral law from the gracious hand of their King Jesus. God makes us love His law, including His fourth commandment, in which He calls His people to cease from our own works on the Lord's Day, if they are not works of mercy, piety, or necessity, and, positively,
Church: *to sanctify the day by special exercises of public and private worship.*
