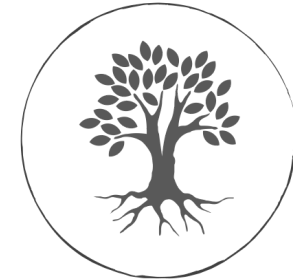

LORD'S SUPPER

We share The Lord's Supper together every week. To partake in a worthy manner (1 Cor. 11:17-34), we must treasure Christ and examine ourselves. If you love Jesus Christ and rest in Him alone for salvation as he is offered to you in the gospel, if you are a baptized member in good standing of a local church that preaches the gospel of God's free grace, and if you are living in ongoing repentance and gratitude in Christ, then this Supper is for you. However, if you have not received Christ as your only salvation, we ask that you abstain from this sacrament to reflect on the gospel message you have heard today. Out of care for their souls, children partake only after being disciplined by a pastor for baptism as their first act of obedience.

Church: ***In all my distress and persecution I turn my eyes to the heavens and confidently await as judge the very One who has already stood trial in my place before God and so has removed the whole curse from me. All his enemies and mine he will condemn to everlasting punishment: but me and all his chosen ones he will take along with him into the joy and the glory of heaven.***
