BAPTISM AND THE LORD'S SUPPER

Jesus gave His church two “visible words:” baptism and The Lord's Supper. Both express our union with Him. Christ commands His disciples: believe, be baptized, publicly profess your faith, and submit yourself to a local church. Jesus commands His church to “make disciples, baptizing *them*.” His disciples “continue steadfastly in the apostles’ doctrine, in fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers.” The Lord's Supper is an ordinance designed for the local church, symbolizing the shared commitment of its members to Christ and to each other. When we eat this bread and drink this cup together, we proclaim the Lord's death, and also our shared life in His body as His blood-purchased church, until He comes again. (1 Corinthians 11:26). We welcome to Christ's table here disciples of Jesus who are sincerely taking steps to obey all that Christ has commanded—whether here or in another true gospel-preaching church. Because the practices of different places sometimes cause confusion about these matters, we invite you to speak with one of our elders for guidance about your situation.

OUR GUILT

CONFESSION OF SIN *[sit]*

Reader: God's moral law commands all people: "you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength" (Deut. 6:5) and "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Mark 12:31). The fifth commandment is, Honor your father and mother. Under the misery of sin, we are unable to keep even God's fifth moral commandment: left to ourselves, we dishonor father, mother, and authorities.

JESUS CHRIST

Church: *Yet, while we were lost in our sin, God made Christ, who knew no sin, to be sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (Rom. 8:3–4).*

PROFESSION OF FAITH: The Chalcedonian Creed, 451 A.D.

We confess faith in our Lord Jesus Christ: perfect in His divinity and also perfect in His manhood; truly God and truly man, of a reasonable soul and body. (...) He took on two natures—inconfusedly, unchangeably, indivisibly, and inseparably; the distinction of His natures by no means took away from their union, but rather the property of each nature of Christ is preserved and concurs in His one Person: (...) the same Son, God the Word, the Lord Jesus Christ, in all things like unto us, yet without sin; begotten of the Father before all ages according to the Godhead, for us and for our salvation.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON *[stand]*

Reader: God promises His people: "I will cleanse you from all your iniquity by which you've sinned against Me, and in Christ, God has pardoned all our iniquities by which we have transgressed against Him. (Jer. 33:8)

GRATITUDE

Reader: Followers of Christ joyfully receive the moral law from the gracious hand of their King Jesus. (Hebrews 8:10, Psalm 119:97) God makes us love His law, including His fifth commandment, in which He calls His people to honor and obey, within the bounds of Scripture, all authorities, whether in family, church, state, or business; and, if we are in authority, to deal reasonably and lovingly with those we lead,
