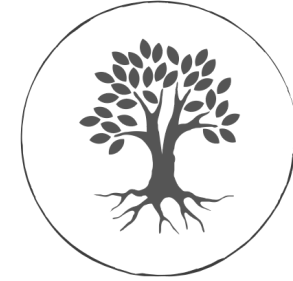

LORD'S SUPPER

We share The Lord's Supper together every week. Young believers are called first to be disciplined and baptized; after that, they may join the congregation at the table. To partake in a worthy manner (1 Cor. 11:17-34), we must treasure Christ and examine ourselves. You are invited to take from the Lord's table if you love Jesus Christ and rest in Him alone for salvation as he is offered to you in the gospel, if you are a baptized member in good standing of a true local church, or if you are taking steps toward that, and if you are living in ongoing repentance and gratitude in Christ. However, if you have not received Christ as your only salvation or if you are living in active disobedience to Him, don't take the bread and cup today. Instead, respond to the gospel you have heard by repenting.
